Our ReStore is our largest source of funding. We also rely on donations from the building industry to build our houses and repair homes for people aging in place.



ReStore:

- Furniture, household items, tools, books, and appliances in working order or gently used condition, etc.
- Jewelry, art, designer handbags and shoes, wedding dresses, prom dresses, sunglasses, etc.
- Business surplus office equipment, computers or related equipment
- Leftover building supplies for DIYers



For our Building Sites or Habitat operations:

- New flooring, windows, lighting, decking, wood, and other building materials, etc.
- Appliances, plumbing fixtures, electrical supplies, insulation
- New paint and painting supplies
- Tools, vehicles, trailers in operating order
- Walk-in storage units, sheds

We envision a world where everyone has a safe, affordable place to call home because people thrive physically, mentally, and financially when their home environment is safe and secure. We welcome prospective homeowners regardless of faith or belief.

WHAT WE DO?

Habitat for Humanity partners with local businesses, nonprofit organizations, churches, communities, groups, and individuals to build new homes and renovate older homes. Once completed, we provide affordable, zero-interest mortgages for individuals and families based on their income level. To qualify, homeowners' income is typically between 40-80% of the county's median annual income.
